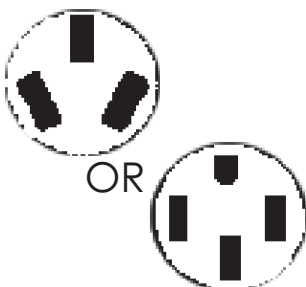
We have invested in the enclosed materials in the hopes that they will be put to good use to get the word out to your community. Enclosed, you will find a news release for advertising the concert in your local newspapers and on local radio and television stations (also for use in church flyers and bulletins, etc.). You will also find several posters for displaying at businesses in your community, and also at your facility. We would encourage you to advertise this meeting however you can, as it will be a prime opportunity for unsaved folks in your community to come under the hearing of the Gospel and be presented with an opportunity to accept Christ. It has been our experience that many folks who avoid normal church services may consider coming to a special event such as this. We have posted this meeting on our web sites at WWW.BILLYSPEER.COM and WWW.DARTTMUSIC.COM and it will also be printed in Singing News magazine.

Because there will be two singing groups present, **we would appreciate it if, upon arrival, you would have three 8-foot or 6-foot tables set up in the area where you would like for us to put our sales display.** Our typical sales displays include cd's, cassettes, printed music, books, T-shirts, & hats. If this is a problem in your church, please let us know where the best area to sell our product would be. Also, we would appreciate the pulpit being moved off to the side prior to arrival, thus ensuring plenty of room for us to work with, and shortening our set-up time.

Lastly, we'd like you to be aware that we are 2 full-time traveling groups; **The finances derived from our concerts and meetings are our only source of income. Please be considerate of this with regard to the availability of these funds at the time of our meeting with you. In order to avoid financial confusion, we ask that the total offering/honorarium/expense amounts be divided equally between 2 separate checks, one made out to "Billy Speer Ministries", and one made out to "The Dartts".** Many of our hosts choose to **add an expense check** to the love offering and/or honorarium to help offset the rising costs of travel (i.e., 50 cents per group, per mile for diesel fuel alone). All that we ask is that you take into consideration the expenses that we are faced with as we travel on the road full-time. We do not require lodging, as we have sleeping facilities on our tour bus and RV. **If 220-volt electrical hookups (as described below) are not available on the premises, an RV park with a 50-amp hookup (such as a KOA) might be an alternative. For your information, The Dartts' tour bus is 45 foot in length, 13 & a half foot tall, 8 & a half foot wide (no slide-outs), & weighs about 28 tons. The Speers' RV is 40 foot long, with an additional 20 foot in-tow, 13 foot tall, 8 & a half foot wide (plus optional slide-outs), & weighs about 20 tons.** Occasionally we are challenged by the presence of low-hanging trees and steep driveways. Please call if you have any questions.

Thank you for this opportunity to share our music with you. It is our prayer that the Lord will use this opportunity for His glory and that souls will come to Christ and Christians will be encouraged as they grow in the knowledge of God and His Word.

P.S. In order to plug our tour bus & RV into your electrical supply, we will need two ELECTRIC STOVE outlets OR two 220 volt / 50amp RV outlets within 90 foot of our rigs.
If only 1 is available, it will be necessary to run power from 2 separate 20-amp outlets on different breakers from one another. If this is not possible, we may be able to hard-wire our power supply directly into a breaker box. Please call if you have questions.
